

# knitted glasses case

Use fabric strips as the basis of this unusual knitting project.

## materials

- 25cm patterned cotton fabric – green tones
- 25cm patterned cotton fabric – pink tones
- 1 pair 5.00mm knitting needles
- scissors
- large eye tapestry needle

### step 1

Cut or tear 1-1.5cm strips from both fabrics selvedge to selvedge. Tie them together alternating the colours then wrap into a ball.

### step 2

Using the knitting needles and fabric strip cast on 12 stitches. Work in

stocking stitch (knit one row, purl one row), keeping the knots on the wrong side. Continue until the work measures 35cm from the beginning and cast off.

### step 3

Fold the knitted piece in half with the right sides facing and sew the sides together using the large eye tapestry

needle and a strip of fabric taking care to pass the needle through the stitches not the fabric.

### step 4

To create a long handle, plait three strips of fabric together then attach with a few stitches at each side of the knitted case.
